



**Selectmen's Meeting

Administrative:

- The Selectmen reviewed and initialed and/or signed the following:
- A/P & P/R Warrant 14
- School Budget letter
- Email from Jason Angel Re: ADA. Asking if we have appointed an ADA coordinator
- Resignation letter from Health Officer, Rebecca Miller, which will become effective at end of June. Selectmen asked Carol to find out who Bowdoinham will be using in the future.

Other Business:

- Tom Garrepy told the Selectmen he will know next week if North Yarmouth is going to purchase our old fire truck.
- Marc said there will be two more small bills, making a total of four, from MMWAC for the trash that he has taken from the West Rd cleanup day site. Clyde was asked by the selectmen to order signs to warn people not to throw items and trash at this site. They also talked about setting up cameras at the site to spot offenders.
- Clint Cote, Roger Bickford, Edwin Barrett and Ron Morhidge, from Bowdoin's local ATV group came in to discuss what can be done to open up more trails in the Town.
- **Roger** said the Town of Lisbon wants to open Burrough Rd to ATVs. They hope to be minimally invasive. For the last 5 years they have been working on the old rail bed to Lewiston. Roger said they are asking for June 1st to Oct 31st access.
- Marc asked if they have talked to the Owners on the Bowdoin end of Burrough Rd. He said we would probably need to have a public hearing to let people living on either end of the road have a say.
- Clint said most complaints are against 4-wheel drivers. He said for the most part there are minimal complaints as long as people use respect. He said the ATV trails will generate business for the Town store and could be used by cross country skiers, snowmobilers and 4-wheelers.
- Marc said the Town could approach the public with the idea.
- Michelle suggested approaching cross country skiers and snowshoers.

Adjournment: Michelle made the motion, Marc seconded, vote was unanimous and meeting adjourned.
