


**Selectmen's Meeting

- Karen Marston asked the Selectmen who is logging near her home. She said it looks like it might be a subdivision. Clint Cote said Mrs Pratt is retired and is cutting wood for money.
- Clint Cote and Dana Morgan discussed the pros and cons of allowing an ATV trail on Huffs Mill road. Dana said the land is private property and they do not want 4-wheelers on it. The Selectmen said it was discontinued with a public right of way in 1975. Dana said the road is not in the same place as it was when discontinued, so it is now on private property. He said the old road now has large trees growing in it.
- Carol told the Selectmen Roger Roy called and said he did two biggest parts of roof repair. Had to order more and he will finish the other part by Wed 7-26.
- Carol told the Selectmen Sharon Turner at 1909 Augusta Rd called to complain about the animals and stench on the corner of Milllay Road. She needs to know who can be contacted to take care of this. She said she may get some neighbors together to come in to the Selectmen's meeting.
- Deb said someone needs to replace the deck and steps at the recycling center. She had not heard that Phil requested the same thing, but she just went in there and saw that it is unsafe.
- The Selectmen asked Carol to contact Jim Small and Lance Skelton to get estimates for doing this.
