


**Selectmen's Meeting

Selectmen reviewed and initialed and/or signed the following:

- Minutes of July 30, 2018
- A/P and P/R Warrant # 18
- Journal Entry Nos. 18, 19 and 20
- MSAD 75 notices of meetings and agendas for August 9th.
- Email from Don Baker regarding safety hazard where Meadow Road intersects with Rt 125 regarding A manhole cover which is broken leaving a hole about 1 and ½ feet square in the cover. Clyde notified Jr. Card who will notify the State.
- Notification that Duff & Phelps is now property tax agent for Spectra Energy and its subsidiaries
- Update from Xfinity stating they will not be carrying beIN Sports Networks as of August 1, 2018 due to lack of an inability to reach an agreement. They will continue to update customers as they continue to work to reach an agreement to keep customers informed. During this period, they are preparing to activate www.ComcastFacts.com to keep clients up to date.

Other Business:

- A small public recognition party will be held Monday, at 700 PM on August 27th, for Susan Ferris who was chosen for the 2018 Spirit of America Tribute for the Town of Bowdoin. This will be following business at the Selectmen's meeting.
- Tom Garrepy said he signed off on any disaster relief from the summer storm because our losses were not enough to qualify.
- Tom asked the Selectmen if it is okay to put a 30 ft high tripod antenna on top of the Town Office roof to enable the Fire Dept to get internet and Y-Fi. They agreed to do it. They also discussed getting some of the tall pines cut around the building and between the Fire Barn and the Office.
- Tom also asked for permission to use the room in the corner downstairs. The selectmen said it should be okay.
- Mark Rogers had some questions for the Selectmen regarding the Town's contract with Lisbon Emergency Service. Marc explained that the Town payments are simply to provide the availability of an ambulance service for the townspeople.
- JR Card said the Dead River Rd bridge and culvert is looking worse. The State is monitoring the amount that it has been sinking.

- They also talked about the Doughty Rd culvert. JR is trying to get the State to accept ownership and responsibility for replacing it.
- Marc asked Carol to ask Greg about cleaning out the basement.
- Clyde said he is starting rehab on August 16th.
