


Selectmen's Meeting

Tyler Washburn, School Committee member came in and told the Board he was resigning, he was moving and would like to recommend Brandy Robertson, he said she has been at the majority of meetings and is up to date on what has been going on with School Committee. The Selectmen's Board discussed the matter and decided that Brandy Robertson, who was the runner-up in the Town's last School Board election, to be appointed as the School Committee member to fill Tyler Washburn's vacancy.

Deb talked about the Addendum being all signed by both plow drivers and the money being transferred appropriately. The selectmen signed the Addendum as well, it is complete.

The Fire Chief, Tom Garrepy, asked the Board if we would reimburse Greg West for parts on his truck that were damaged when he was going to a fire call, a deer ran in front of his vehicle.
