Reviewed and signed Minutes for 06/20/2022. Motion to accept the minutes by Marc Bernier, second by Deb Marquis, all in favor. Also signed warrants.

Other Business:

 Opened bids for snowplowing, Municipal parking lot and walks, Loader lease and stockpiling winter sand & salt.

Section 1. (12.4 miles) Marc Bernier made the motion, Deborah Marquis seconded all in favor to accept the bid by Rodney Skelton for \$6700.00 per mile per year, plus for every \$1.00 increase in fuel prices from the contract signing, the price per mile will increase \$100.00

Section 2. (12.2 miles) Marc Bernier made the motion, Deborah Marquis seconded and all in favor to accept the bid by Gary Card for \$6800.00 per mile per year.

Section 3. (14.2 miles) Marc Bernier made the motion, Deborah Marquis seconded and all in favor to accept the bid by Chad Halloway for \$6250.00 per mile per year.

Section 4. (10.9 miles) Marc Bernier made the motion, Deborah Marquis seconded and all in favor to accept the bid by Chad Halloway for \$6250.00 per mile per year.

Municipal parking lots and walkways- Marc Bernier made the motion, Deborah Marquis seconded and all in favor to accept the bid by Dana Morgan for \$13,500.00 per year.

Loader Lease- Marc Bernier made the motion, Deborah Marquis seconded and all in favor to accept the bid by Chad Halloway for \$20,000.00 per year.

Winter Sand stockpile- Marc Bernier made a motion, Deborah Marquis seconded, all in favor to accept the bid by Card's Excavation & Tractor Work for \$24.00 per yard of sand.

- It was clarified that for the plowing contracts 1 primary truck and 1 backup truck was needed.
- Question was asked in about the payment schedule as it was stated differently in the same contract.
 The Town will be paying 6 payments instead of quarterly. Also the Town will require 65% of the total contract amount for a bond that is provided by the contractors.
- A citizen from the Wagg rd. was in to discuss the drastic increase of 4-wheeler traffic on the Wagg rd. and the Starbird corner rd. The select board directed her to contact the Warden service for information on the rules.
