Administrative Review and sign minutes for 11/14/2022 Marc Bernier made the motion to accept the 11/14/2022 minutes, Brad Totten second. Abatements were signed.

Other Business:

- Michaeline Mulvey- stated she does not believe it is a good idea for ATV's to travel down Dead River Rd due to the road not having shoulders. She asked if the Town owned any cemeteries. The Town does not. The reason for asking is that it was brought to her attention that some Veterans stones were deteriorating. It was stated that the cemetery association or some groups fix them. It was suggested by Brad to add that information, about the Veterans' stones, to the Select boards letter for next year's Town Meeting Warrant.
- Jim MacDonnell (Lisbon Emergency)- informed the Board that for several days in the month of December they will be manning 2 ambulances. He further stated to be self-sustaining (breakeven), an ambulance service needs 2 calls per day.
- Tom Garrepy stated he was looking at replacing engine 5. The wait time right now is 40 months after ordering. Tom would like to have a proposal possibly for 2024.
- The Board received a letter from the Sagadahoc County Budget Advisory Committee. Marc stated he doesn't wish to serve on the committee, Brad stated he doesn't have time but they will ask if Deborah Marquis would like to.

- The Board received Clyde Cavender's resignation as of December 2, 2022. Marc called Clyde to clarify and asked if he would be willing to help through the transition. Clyde stated he would.
- Marc will follow up with Lance Skelton in regard to replacing the door and window in the recycling building.
- Brad stated that John Lewis would like to put something on the Town website about the Town office addition. Brad said he would talk to him and go over it.
