- Brad Totten called Eric Calderwood (engineer for the Doughty road project) to see if there was possibly
 any emergency funding for the damage done by last night and this morning heavy rains. It completely
 washed out the Doughty Rd where the 2 culverts were slated to be replaced. Jr. Card stated that he
 would be talking with the EMA director (Tom Garrepy) to get prices for the damages. Brad requested
 Jr. Card to keep track of the cost of the damages for the storm done to the rest of the Town.

- Michaeline Mulvey wanted to clarify who the permitting authority would be for the Accessory Dwelling Unit Ordinance. The Board stated it would be the Planning Board.
- Training workshop for Tax Collector and Treasurer will be June 8th and Karan Stark and David Manfredi Will be attending.
- Melanie Page informed the board that when the Town lost power, the generator only covered the old section. Brad said he would contact the electrician.
- There was a lengthy discussion about Bills- Karan Stark brought to the boards attention some bills that were late or unpaid that she had done some research on. Deborah Marquis stated that she didn't believe they were late, but she will work on them.
