Marc stated he spoke with the Lisbon Town Manager last Tuesday night and the Town is actively working on the situation. Lisbon town Manager asked if the Town of Bowdoin would be willing to pay help pay for a temporary bridge for the West Burrough Rd. George asked if anyone has been in touch with Sagadahoc County to see when they are going to declare this an emergency situation on the West Burrough Rd. Still no fire trucks can go up the road. Marc will contact Sarah Bennet, EMA Director, for Sagadahoc.
- The question was asked has the National Guard been contacted and the Board said not by them.
- A resident was in to inform the Board of the continuation of ATV's using the main roads to travel on.
 Many properties have been closed to ATV's by the landowners. The Bowdoin ATV club has been posting on their website that it is ok to travel 1-2 miles on the main roads to get to trails. People are concerned for the safety of the ATV riders and vehicles traveling on the road. The Warden service was contacted by some concerned citizens.

- Michaeline Mulvey stated that she is not getting all the e-mails that come to the Planning Board and asked if the Board would check with John Lewis to see if there is a problem. Planning Board needs a member to replace Jim Moulton.
- The locksmith stated the Board needs to contact the contractor for the building and discuss the front doors. Brad will contact Tyler Golletti.
- Guy Lebida was in asking questions about the resolution for the Doughty Rd bridge. He stated he used to work for the Army National guard and if he could be of any help.
