- Tom Garrepy- Will be meeting with FEMA to hopefully rap up the paperwork on 7 roads that qualified for FEMA funding so the Town can get reimbursed for those. That will just leave the Doughty road to finish paperwork and the repairs plus the new bridge.  
Tom stated the roof repair person is coming to put a new flange on the Fire Dept. roof to stop the leak and that he will inspect the rest of the roof at the same time. Serve Pro has us on their list for inside repairs until all the leaks are repaired.  
Tom is getting estimates for Plymo Vents (to take care of the diesel exhaust from the fire trucks).
- David Towle made a motion to approve the project for installing shelves in the new vault.
