Other Business:

- Jane Boyle, from the Ladies Auxiliary for the Fire Department, requested to use the Town office to
 hold their monthly meeting at the Town Office due to the need for repairs at the Fire station.
 They hold their meetings on Sundays from 2-3 pm. The Board stated it would have to be on a day
 that the Town office had staff working. It was decided they could meet on Thursday afternoon 23 pm. Jane said she would check with the rest of the committee and get back to the Board. Jane
 brought up the issue of the Dead River Road culvert sinking. The Board stated they had discussed
 it with the State engineer.
- David Manfredi (treasurer) presented the amounts expended so far on storm damage, which is \$286,643.50. David stated that the check reader is great, saving a lot of time, and will save a tremendous amount of time when taxes are due in December. He would like to get a 2-drawer filing cabinet that locks. The Board said to get it.
