**Other Business:**

- Darci Wheeler spoke with the Board about being a Public Representative for the Sagadahoc Budget Advisory Committee as there is no one in that position for the Town currently. The Board discussed it and made a motion to appoint Darci as the Public Representative for 1 year. They also discussed appointing someone for the Municipal Representative. Marc made a motion to appoint Darci Wheeler as the Public Representative for the Sagadahoc Budget Advisory Committee for Bowdoin and Brad Totten as the Municipal Representative for the Sagadahoc Budget Advisory Committee for Bowdoin, David second, all in favor.
- Dennis Douglass- discussed with the Board the letter that Ron Dall sent to the Board and his visit with Ron. Dennis said Ron stated that his issue is that the Town has/had a failed septic system that blew out the side and is leaching into his well. The second issue that Ron has is that he feels the Town knew about the failed system and didn't tell anyone. Dennis discussed with him the procedure for getting an accurate test done, by a professional, on his well.
- Andy and Diane Rice were in to discuss the ongoing problem at the end of their driveway at 165 Wood schoolhouse Rd. The driveway continues to wash out during heavy rains. Wendall Card has replaced

the culvert with a larger one, but it has again started to wash out. They would like to know if there is a solution to prevent this from happening. The Board said they would talk with Wendall and hopefully find a solution.

- Board- Marc made a motion, David second, all in favor to sign the new one-year contract for the Web monitoring program.

  - Marc Stated the ACO cost will be going up approximately \$200, and that the Ambulance service budget will be voted on Thursday (at next meeting in Lisbon).
