

**Other Business:**

- Lisbon Emergency Chief Amy Cailler was in to talk to the Board about the budget that was approved for the Ambulance services. They added two full time paramedics that will be on duty from 6am to 6am (24 hrs.). To help supplement the cost of the service, they will do daytime transports for non-emergency patients (like going to an appointment that needs ambulance service). Bowdoin had 265 calls last year. The chief stated that they applied and received a \$50,000 grant to purchase a vehicle for a supervisor, which would enable the supervisor to get to the call and help out.
- Jr. Card- The Board talked with Jr about possibilities of ways to fix the road/end of driveway for 165 Woodschool House rd. Jr. stated he has already put 2-24" culverts in there.
- Tom Garrepy- Tom updated the Board on the progress of the fire station repairs. The Board will discuss putting out a bid for repairs.
- Gordon Johnson called Melanie and stated the Bowdoinham water district will go up 3.5%.
