They met with the residents and Jeff offered 2 loads of gravels even though he felt he did not damage to the road to warrant 2 loads of gravel. The residents could not all agree and thought 2 loads of gravel was not enough and refused it. Greg Foster stated that Jeff treated the residents of the road very well in that he plowed and sanded the road all winter so that his trucks did not pack down the snow. Brad Totten had taken before and after photos which showed the potholes were there before Jeff started trucking across the road. The Board suggested that Brad download the pictures so they could look at them on the big screen in the office.


