**Other Business:**


- Select Board- Marc received information from Amber Jones about a survey to have an option to make split payments for the County Budget. The Board voted **"To authorize the Select Board to inform Sagadahoc County and the other county municipalities that Bowdoin would prefer to pay its' County Tax in two installments and work with county administration to see if a mutually beneficial payment schedule can be developed for FY 2027"**. After discussing the option, the Board felt that the Town would like the option for two installments if the Town needed to. **Marc made the motion to accept, Jane second, all in favor.** Marc requested Melanie to send an email to Amber Jones to verify the vote.  
Maine Waste to Energy is requesting a one-time payment of nearly \$19,000 (for FY 2027) for equipment upgrades at the facility in Auburn. The equipment is 33 years old and parts that are needed are mostly obsolete. Jane stated that Maine Waste to Energy is encouraging people, or

your trash hauler, to bring their trash to the Auburn facility. (this is where they make their money).
