Administrative: reviewed and signed warrants for 05/04/2026. Minutes for 04/30/2026 were approved, motion by Marc, second by Jane, both in favor.

- Amanda Griffin was in for Clarence Bishop, to get an update on 848 East Burrough Rd. She stated there is an ongoing problem with septic runoff and trash on the property. She stated instead of it being cleaned up it is just being moved around on the property. Dennis Douglass codes enforcement office stated that he is working with the property owner (Johnny Staples) and that Johnny has removed some stuff from the property. Other stuff is being sorted so there are piles of wood and metal on the property. The codes enforcement is and has been following the progress of the property.
- Ray Curit of Roberts Road would like to put a fence up on his property near the road and wanted to know what the setback is and if the Town planned on widening the Roberts Road. Mr. Curit had been in to see the Planning Board, but they told him he didn't need to get their permission. The Board stated that the fence should not be constructed in the Towns Road right of way. There are no plans to widen Roberts Road but there will be a couple of culverts replaced, and the road will be paved. (Wendall Card Jr., operator of the Quarry, has stated he will donate the money for the cost of the culverts and paving.) The Board will get back to Ray on what the road right of way is. Daniel Mitchele, of Roberts Road, would like to see the traffic enter off Meadow Road and exit onto Rte. 125. He also questioned the use of Jake brakes.

- Email regarding the proposed Bowdoin Mobile Home Lot Rent Stabilization Ordinance-The Board stated that they would contact the Town Attorney for his advice on the legality of the proposed Ordinance and see what it would cost to have the Attorney review the Ordinance. The Board will also contact Dan Neuman of Maine Climate Control (spokesman for the proposed Ordinance) to see if they are willing to pay the lawyer cost.
