6:30 PM: Pledge of Allegiance

Administrative: reviewed and signed the warrant for 06/01/2026. Minutes were approved for 05/18/2026, motion by Marc second by Brad, both in favor.

- **Wendall Card Jr** wanted to know the timeline for paving Roberts Road. The Board stated that Seth would be getting prices from contractors to replace culverts on Roberts Road before it is paved. Wendall was concerned that the cost is going up each week. Salt Shed- when will the Town be doing the bracing on the inside of the salt shed? Wendall wants to line up trucks to haul winter sand before fall rains. The Board is looking into a timeline. The Board asked Wendall for a copy of the packet he presented for the Quarry. He stated he would bring it in.
- **Michaeline Mulvey**, Chair of the Planning Board and residents of Wagg Road, Scott and Nicole Deschaines, wanted to divide their property but don't have Town maintained road frontage. They wanted to know if there was anything they could do to get a building permit. The Select Board said they will need to first speak with the abutters on Wagg Road from where the Town maintained section ends to their property, get permission to upgrade the road to Town Standard from where the Town maintained section ends to the beginning of their property and continue for another 300 feet. They then will need to build the road to Town Standard, have it inspected and signed off by the Road Commissioner

and then would be eligible for a building permit. The Town still would not be responsible for maintaining that section of road.

- *Seth Skelton brought in an estimate for paving 2.25 miles on the Lewis Hill Road, from Eric Sheens' to Greg West fields. (Roughly \$310,000.) Seth stated he will have an estimate for Roberts Road next week. Seth will notify the Board and the Towns' people the day he will be closing Lewis Hill Road to remove some large pine trees across from the Hix Small cemetery.*
