Administrative: reviewed and signed the warrant for 06/15/2026. Minutes were approved for 06/08/2026, motion by Jane, second by Brad, all in favor.

Jerry Highfill, resident of Mountain View Estates, came in to discuss the Mobil Home Park Rent Stabilization ordinance petition that was being circulated. Jerry wanted to know if the Town would be having a Special Town Meeting on the Ordinance. It was explained that AFTER the names on the petition have been certified, the Town will set a date for a Public Hearing and then after the Public Hearing a date will be set for a Special Town Meeting. Jerry wanted the Select Board to support the proposed Ordinance. The Board told Jerry that the Maine Climate Board did not want to pay to have the Towns' Attorney look at the proposed Ordinance to ensure it was an ordinance that was enforceable. The representative from the Maine Climate Board felt what they presented was fine as it was an identical ordinance recently passed by another Town.
