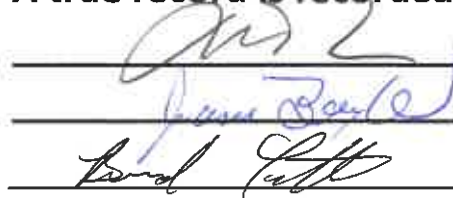




**Select Board Meeting

Administrative: reviewed and signed the warrant for 07/20/2026. Minutes were approved for 07/13/2026, motion by Marc, second by Brad, all in favor.

-Clint Cote- Expressed his and others concerns with the constraints of using East Burrough Road to get to the Quarry on Roberts Road. East Burrough Road is posted for no thru traffic over 16,000 lbs. He and other truckers also are not pleased with the 7:00 opening time. He stated truckers who are trucking down to the Islands cannot get in a full day. Clint stated Jr. Card is paving Roberts Road out of his own pocket. The Board stated Roberts Road was not scheduled to be paved this year, but Jr. wanted it paved for his customers/truckers, so he wanted to pay to have it paved. Clint stated his family all pay their taxes and these are Public Roads that the Town should be taking care of.

-Scott and Nichole Deshaines- presented a survey map on proposed upgrade (to Town standards) of a section of Wagg Road to create 300' of Road frontage for their existing lot, to create a backlot on their existing lot. Map 10 lot 09-01 and then creating lot 09-02.

Melanie Page- Melanie finished certifying the petition for the Proposed Mobile Home Rent Stabilization Ordinance. They do have enough signatures. Melanie will contact Michaeline from the Planning Board to

have the Planning Boards input. The Board will set a date for a Public Hearing at a future Select Board Meeting and possible Special Town Meeting.
