Administrative: reviewed and signed the warrant for 08/10/2026. Minutes were approved for 08/03/2026, motion by Marc, second by Jane, all in favor.

Sydney MCOG- the Board signed the Partnership with MCOG Resilience Partnership and she took it back.

Michael Stanfield -of Civic Chain was checking to see if the Board had set a time to meet with him about his business. The Board has set a tentative date for 8/31/2026 if John Lewis (IT) can make that date.

Lance Skelton- wanted to make the Board aware that the tarred ramp coming into the Town Office is not up to code. He stated this is a public building and should be up to code. The Board stated they are aware and Brad will get the exact code for the ramp. Lance also wanted to know what was going on at the salt shed. Brad stated he and Engineer Helen Watts have proposed a design to diagonally brace the walls and trusses to prevent the walls from moving. Lance asked to see the design and wanted to be informed when they were going down so he could look it over. He stated also that he felt the appropriations ratio on the tax bill was incorrect, that MSAD#75 portion was actually higher.

Seth- Crooker will be paving Roberts Road on Wednesday and they have postponed paving Lewis Hill Road until the first week in September. The Board asked Seth to take down the no thru truck 16,000 lbs and over on Roberts Road, East Burrough Road and Doughty Road as soon as Rte. 125/Main St is opened. Seth stated

the bridge on West Burrough Road is planned to be replaced in 2028-2029. Also Rte. 125 east of Rte 201 won't be finished until December 2026.
